



INTERNATIONAL ETCHELLS CLASS 2016 World Championship

AMENDMENT TO NOTICE OF RACE NO 1

2. RULES

Insert 2.7

2.7 The Organising Authority will supply and affix Bow Sticker numbers before racing which may not be removed or moved. It is the responsibility of competitors to ensure that these are in place before leaving the dock each day.

3. ADVERTISING

3.1 Delete 'The Organising Authority may require all participating boats to display the event sponsor's advertising in accordance with World Sailing Regulation 20.4.1'.

Insert 'The Organising Authority will require all participating boats to display the event sponsor's advertising logo in accordance with World Sailing Regulation 20.4.1'. The sponsor's logo shall be affixed to both sides of the hull with the aft edge in line with the front of the chain plate'.

13. INTERNATIONAL JURY

Delete 13.2

Arbitration will not be available.

15. HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

15.1 Delete 'All boats shall be afloat before 1700 on Saturday 3 September 2016 and shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the International Jury. The penalty may be DSQ for any subsequent races'.

Insert 'All boats shall be afloat at the Regatta Venue (Cowes Yacht Haven) before 1700 on Saturday 3 September 2016 and shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the International Jury. The penalty may be DSQ for any subsequent races'.

16. PLASTIC POOLS Add 'AND BREATHING APPARATUS'

Insert 16.2

16.2 The use of breathing apparatus, including snorkels, is not allowed from 1700 on Saturday 3 September 2016 until after the last race of the regatta. Any swimmer must be accompanied by a watcher close by.

24. PHOTOGRAPHIC WAIVER

Insert

24.1 Competitors shall grant to the Organising Authority without payment the right in perpetuity to make, use and show any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television of or relating to the event.
